High Blood Pressure Guide

- **Are there high blood pressure symptoms?** One of the most dangerous aspects of hypertension is that you may not know you have it. Nearly 1/3 of the people who have it don't know it.
- **Warning signs:** In most cases there are no warning signs, but blood pressure can become dangerously high and threaten your organs and life.
- Types unlike hypertension, the less common secondary hypertension is the result of another disorder such as kidney disease or sleep apnea.
- **Pre-hypertension:** Anyone with a systolic (top #) of 120 or over and a diastolic (bottom #) of 80 or over now have pre-hypertension, which means an increased risk of heart disease or stroke.
- **Complications of hypertension:**
- Atherosclerosis-C increases your chance of coronary artery disease.
- Stroke:A stroke occurs when blood flow to an area of the brain is cut off and people with high blood pressure are 4-6 times more likely to have a stroke.
- Heart disease is the #1 cause of death associated with hypertension.
- Kidney disease: hypertension is a major cause of kidney disease and failure.
- Eye disease: untreated hypertension can affect your eyesight causing damage to the blood vessels in the retina.
- Diabetes: Hypertension is a risk factor for the development of diabetes, and having diabetes increases your risk of developing hypertension.
