Mornings Hope Consolation Ministry

Every 29 seconds a family somewhere in the U.S. will experience the death of a child, whether it be from an early pregnancy loss through that of a young adult. I felt this heartbreak personally when my son, Brian, died in 1992. It was through the friendship, understanding and hope provided by The Compassionate Friends that I was able to survive this most terrible of nightmares. Every month The Compassionate Friends, through its 600 chapters and the National Organization, provides bereavement support to tens of thousands of families.

The Compassionate Friends is hosting its 34th National Conference in Minneapolis, Minnesota July 15-17. Information is available at their website: www.compassionatefriends.com.

The conference is unique in that it consists of workshops, meetings and platform presentations by those whose lives have been touched by the death of a child: bereaved parents, grandparents, siblings. There are also a few professionals presenting, but not many.

The credo of TCF is "We Not Walk Alone" and the highlight of the weekend is the Walk to Remember. On Sunday morning July 17, volunteers will carry the names of thousands of children loved, missed and remembered. How do they get the names? Members and other interested persons submit the names either by mail or through the website: www.tcfwalktoremember.org. All requests must be made by July 7. I have attended a national conference and recommend it without reservation. For more information, leave a message at the rectory.
