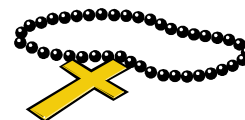

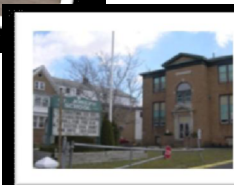
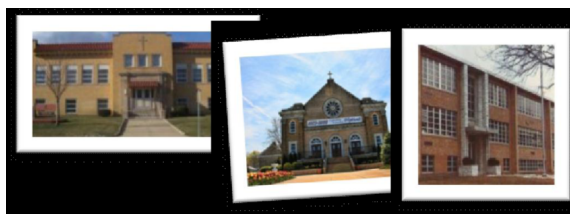

# Celebrate the Rich History of The Bayshore's Catholic Schools

Dear Friends,

Mother Teresa Regional School opened its doors in September of 2006 to welcome students from Our Lady of Perpetual Help and Saint Agnes Schools. The parish of Saint Catherine Laboure which had closed it's school years previously also sponsored the new school. In 2009, three additional schools along the Bayshore closed, Holy Family, Saint Ann and Saint Joseph.

The history of these six schools is the history of Mother Teresa Regional School. Without the dedication of generations of parents, teachers, pastors, and the religious women who often led these schools, Mother Teresa Regional School would not exist.

As Mother Teresa Regional School prepares to celebrate its fifth year, we want to honor and remember the legacy of those who came before us. We are seeking alumni from Holy Family, Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Saint Joseph, Saint Agnes, Saint Ann and Saint Catherine to share their stories with us and their history. The students will be working to create a video of interviews of alumni remembering their days at the schools and stories especially of the women religious; the Sisters of Mercy, the Carmelites, the Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia, The Sisters of St. Francis of Penance and Christian Charity at Stella Niagara, and the Sisters of St. Francis of the Infant Jesus.
